- 1967 Plymouth GTX Hemi - Four-speed, original 426 hemi engine, carbs and exhaust manifolds, 4:10 rear end and build sheet. Equipped with power steering, power brakes, console and tachometer. Original sheet metal. A true American muscle car capable of 0-60 in less than 5 seconds!
- 1967 Chevrolet Corvette Coupe - Big block 427 cu. in. engine. Total body-off restoration with no expense spared. Complete documentation, with every owner dating back to 1967. Comes with original protect-o-plate and window sheet.
- 1968 Chevrolet Camaro RS/SS - 396 cu. in., 375hp and automatic transmission. Fifteen factory options including, power steering, power disc brakes, console with gauges and deluxe hound's-tooth interior. A true RS/SS big block car with recent restoration. Three-time Best of Show winner.

During the auction weekend, RM will also host an indoor swap meet featuring automotive parts and accessories, literature and collectibles. In addition, a huge assortment of automobilia, including signs, toys, memorabilia, pop machines and antique gas pumps, will be offered for auction.
